



### Consumer Prices 2001 - 2019



#### Interest Rates 2001 - 2019






### WMSA Payroll Job Change: Private Sector The Great Recession and Recovery








## Annual Job Change Washington MSA, 2002-2014








#### 15 Largest Job Markets Job Change: Aug 2013 – Aug 2014










### Job Change by Sector Aug 2013 – Aug 2014 Washington MSA




### Job Change by Sector Jul 2014 – Aug 2014 Washington MSA








### Annual Job Change Northern Virginia, 2002-2014





Month-Over-Year 2000 - 2014, MSA






#### Average Sales Price Percent Change Metro Area – Single Family Detached









## Comparison of YoY Change in Closed Sales and Listings Aug 2014




